

Old Selam Intro Ride for Trail Riders

Old Selam Non-Competitive Intro Rides are offered Friday, Saturday, and Sunday of Labor Day Weekend, concurrently with our competitive Endurance Ride. Come ride at your own pace on our beautiful trails. Trails are marked and water is available on trail for horses. Our scenic loops will take you through scenic New Centerville area with your choice of a 8.5 or 13 mile loop. You will get the opportunity to have your horse vetted through with our onsite veterinarians as part of your entry fee. Come for the day or camp overnight and enjoy beautiful trails that cross into private and National Forest Lands.

CLUB CHALLENGE: The local riding club with the most entries, will win a weekend of private access / use of our Ride Camp location in June of 2025, complete with a catered campfire breakfast.

WEED FREE HAY is required as trails cross over into National Forests. Water will be available for horses. Bring your own potable water.

Where: Beautiful Boise Basin, New Centerville. Ride Camp is approximately 9 miles Northwest from Idaho City on the Grimes Creek Road Just east of New Centerville Road.

From I-84 in Boise take Hwy 21 NE 36 miles to Idaho City. Turn Left (north) onto Montgomery St. At the end of the street, turn left (west) and continue for 9 miles (dirt road between towns) to Centerville. Turn right (north) onto Henry's creek Rd. and continue approx. ½ mile into camp. **GPS Coordinates: Latitude: 43.88627 Longitude: -115.90513**

HOOF PROTECTION STRONGLY RECOMENDED! The majority of trails are FABULOUS FOOTING, however, there are some sections where you must travel over former mine tail areas, and rocks can be an issue for an unprotected hoof.

When: Friday & Saturday August 30th &31st and, Sunday, September 1st. Ride Camp opens up on Thursday, August 29th.

Food: Bring your own food. Mrs Smallz catering will have food available as well.

Intro Ride Fee: \$35.00 per Horse and Rider Team per day you ride.
